■ To keep in mind

 Many young people – at the cusp of what they're going to become in life – still see no meaning and purpose in their lives. How can pray for and guide them?

■ Key points to remember

- o What a world our young people face today. How can we nurture and pray for them?
- o Identity and social media we can help our young people walk wisely now and into the future.
- As our sons and daughters / grandsons and granddaughters mature where are they getting their guidance, direction, and values – as well as community? Most is from social media today.
- Our young people are being mentored and discipled via social media with thoughts, values, ideas, and ideals, which are usually far from truth, far from those who love them, and far from God.
- Girls and boys as young as ten years old are now suffering from anxiety and depression largely due to identity crises brought on by social media.
- There is a spiritual dimension to this and there are those who are set against our young people ruining their lives and turning them from God.
- We and young people especially cannot afford to put off faith in God and the Creator. God wants the best of their lives now.
- Their identity is not rooted in the sexual orientation, or group identity they are rooted in the image and likeness of God.

Here's how you can pray this week

- Remember that our Creator is in charge remember Him in the days of our youth.
- Let's pray together fervently with hearts of faith and expectation
- Let's pray in two directions:
 - Youth
 - for protection from the insidious effects of social media.
 - That parents will take the huge step of having conversations with their children about the power of their electronic devices
 - Role models
 - Parents, older siblings, older fellow students at school or church.
 - For God to send good people into the lives of our children
- For protection for our children that they might be aware of the messages coming to them through social media, and that they might be able, through your power, to control their usage.
- To trust You for their protection

- o For the responsibility we have, as adults, for the young people in our midst.
- o For their hearts and minds to be solidly focused on You.
- o For good role models to give our young people living examples of Christlikeness.
- o Send good people into the lives of our children and grandchildren.
- We claim your grace, mercy, and undying love for us.
